

In 2011, Sarah won the Storylines Joy Cowley Award for her picture book, *Wooden Arms* (Scholastic, 2012), which is also available in te reo Māori as *Poupou Tauawhi* (Scholastic, 2012). In 2016, her junior fiction novel, *The Bold Ship Phenomenal* (Flat Bed Press, 2015) received a Storylines Notable Book Award, and was shortlisted for the New Zealand Book Awards for Children and Young Adults. The first book in the Spaghetti Giraffe series, *The Spaghetti Giraffe* (Flat Bed Press, 2017) also received a Storylines Notable Book Award in 2016. Along with illustrator Deborah Hinde, Sarah received a Copyright Licensing New Zealand grant in 2020 for their picture book *Enough: A Story About Community* (PictureBook Publishing, 2021) and a Creative New Zealand grant in 2021 for the picture book *Harold's Spots* (Waipa-King Country Life Education Trust, 2022).

Sarah works full-time as a writer, creating books and stories for trade and educational publishers in New Zealand and overseas. *Spaghetti Giraffe and the Chaos Cake* will be the seventh book she has produced with friend and colleague Deborah Hinde.
